Daily Schedule.

9:00am til 4:00pm, Monday through Thursday.

Campers, please arrive between 8:40 and 9:00. NOTE: LITz arrive 8:30-8:40 am.

9:00 am til 6:00pm on Friday for Family FEST.

8:30-8:40: The Leaders-In-Training arrive before the Campers, report directly to their LIT Camp Site.

8:40-9:00: Meadow Reverie-*a meadow in simplicity is mythical in artistry-*. Blankets unfurl on meadow in a festive flag raising sound of summer softness. Campers are welcomed as they gather together with their counselors under wizened apple trees.

9:00-9:30: Cabins. Each Camper group of 5-7 Campers has their own Cabin with their own Counselor and SAV. The Cabins become tree houses, Hobbit dens, nests. The cabins are special club houses for special campers. *(The SAVz are high school volunteers who assist the Camp Staff.)*

9:40 – 10:50. The first two of four 30 minute Encampment Experiences with Professional Artists//Instructors :*(Encampments and artists for each week will be posted)*

Encampments in Visual Art, Music, Dance, Theater, Nature Arts are scheduled every week. A variety of other encampments rotate across the five weeks. Examples: journaling, weaving, drumming, opera, stage craft, sculpture, spArts n' games, Knighthood. Bird Watching, Fiber Arts, Signing.

11:00-11:30: FIRST FEAST at The Forum. A First Nation Silent pause, and Food for Thought in Stillness reflection, toasts ever FEAST. **The Art of Manners and Elegant Ettiquette** is very cool, highly valued, praised and rewarded. Please pack **cloth napkins** for your Camper. Thank you.

Live Entertainment sweetly seasons the FEAST atmosphere. The presentations vary from day to day. Great art and artists are enjoyed, recognized and applauded as camp staff, campers, and guest artists present classic scenes from theater,song, dance, a Potpourri of Artistry.

The Caravan of Clever, Stylish, Traveling Artisans of Hand Art and Pookas, roll out their booths at the FEASTS for those who wish to participate.

Trashy Art is created from the spoils of the FEASTS. We recycle, too.

11:40 til 12:50: Last two of four encampments.

1:00-2:00: MYTHICAL ABUNDANT FEAST with much that is GREEK.

Theater, Chorus, Myth, in Grand Greek Glory! And other good stuff, too: skits, songs, performances, special guests; cabin myths and Heroines and Heroes and Creatures. And:

~Anne and Twig at the Piazza~ An Interactive Meadow Opera of Love. With Love Songs and Classic Poetry of Love. Directed by the Campers.

Before each FEAST everyone in Camp must wash their hands thoroughly with soap and very warm water and scrub while singing 99 Grecian Urns on the Wall down to 95 Grecian Urns.

2:15-3:15: All Camp Afternoon Events: Monday, Wednesday, Friday: ARTIST'S SPOTLIGHT- Inspired people from all walks of life come to our Camp as volunteers to share their enthusiasm and inspiration with the Campers and Staff. People who have a certain eager quality in who they are and what they do, who see life as an art form. They are lit from the inside out. Such people bring comfort and joy to others just by being themselves. When they walk into a room everything and everyone perks up then settles down. Calm. Alert. Peaceful. Some such people are known as artists. Others come cloaked in all sorts of different costumes.
